A circular walk to Kitchenor's Memorial. It is a steep incline up to Marwick Head from the Marwick Bay car park. Although still up hill, it's easier from the car park at Midcomloquoy. The cliffs at Marwick Head are very high, please take care near the cliff edge, especially on windy days.

Marwick Head is a RSPB reserve and has one of the largest seabird colonies in Orkney, with every ledge and crevice occupied by nesting birds during the summer.
